

## QUESTIONS FOR DISCUSSION

1. What does the praise offered to God (vs. 6) indicate?
2. What are the requirements of being part of the bride?
3. Who comprise the army of God? The army of the beast? How great will be the battle?
4. Is it inconsistent to think that a God of love would also wage war? (See vs. 11)

### SUMMARY:

We have a picture of the worshippers of God declaring God as being omnipotent and that He is reigning. It indicates that He now has complete control. The day when men could choose for themselves and when Satan could persuade men will be at an end. In righteousness, complete and total, shall He reign.

It is only after all sin has been brought into His power will the marriage of the Lamb and His bride take place. The bride is presented in her adornment of white, fine linen which is the spirit-led work of righteousness of the saints.

Even though all power belongs to God, Satan will still try to war against the followers of God. However, the messengers of Satan, the beast and the false prophet will be taken captive and will be cast into the lake of fire. All of the armies of Satan will be utterly destroyed. God truly will reign supreme.

**QUARTERLY THEME:** Christ, The Triumphant Lord

**TOPIC:** SATAN, A DEFEATED FOE

**INTRODUCTION:**

After the beast and false prophet are cast into the lake of fire, an angel takes Satan, binds him with a great chain, and casts him into the bottomless pit for 1,000 years. Satan is loosed again after this period.

Those who bear a testimony for the Lord and those who gave their lives for His namesake now live and reign with Christ for 1,000 years. This rule will be as with a rod of iron. All men on earth will reverence and worship the Lord. Those who rule with Jesus are counted in the first resurrection. Blessed, holy is he who hath part in the first resurrection.

After the 1,000 years are passed, Satan will again deceive many people who will rise against Christ and all His saints. God will judge decisively and quickly and shall destroy this multitude with fire. Satan then shall be cast into the lake of fire where the beast and false prophet **are** still after the 1,000 years. Their torment will continue day and night forever.

Then comes the great white throne judgment. All the dead who have no part in the first resurrection are now raised and are judged by the things written in the books according to their works. No voice of protest will apparently be raised. There can be no defense, as all men will have their works revealed. How terrible to stand before an all-knowing God, who even judges the secrets of men (Romans 2:16), knowing the truth of the record! Only one thing shall spare men from this great judgment: having their names written in the book of life. For all others, they shall be cast into the lake of fire. Note that the Word says nothing about good works alone gaining us entry into heaven. But good works—through the power of Christ—allows that our names can be in this Book of Life.

**CENTRAL TRUTH:** No power is able to prevent the triumph of Christ.

**GOLDEN TEXT: *I SAW THE DEAD, SMALL AND GREAT, STAND BEFORE GOD; AND THE BOOKS WERE OPENED: AND ANOTHER BOOK WAS OPENED, WHICH IS THE BOOK OF LIFE.***

Revelation 20:12

As John looked upon the great white throne the majesty and awesomeness of the One who sat on it was so great that the heaven and earth, God's creation, fled away. Now there was no hiding place for the dead both small and great, rich and poor, who now must stand before the throne for judgment. The books are opened and every man is judged by what is written. What has been written on your page of this book? What all in your life will condemn you?

Another book is opened, the book of life. If our names are written in the book of life then our page in "the books" is removed. All our sins have been erased by the blood of the Lamb. The difference between life and death eternally will depend on which book will contain our name. May we sing with the hymn writer, "Is my name written there, on the page white and fair? In the book of thy kingdom, **yes**, my name's written there."
